



INTERVIEW SAMPLE QUESTIONS

First, think of an interview situation and how you would prepare for questions. It could be an interview for a high school job, a college interview, or a job you wish to have as an adult. Use the questions below to think of how you would answer each question.

1. What made you consider applying for this job?
2. What are your strengths?
3. What are your weaknesses?
4. Tell me about a time you have led a project.
5. How would your best friend describe you?
6. Where do you see yourself in three years? Five years?
7. Share an example of when you were a team player.
8. Do you have any questions for me? (THE ANSWER SHOULD BE YES!)

Here are some examples of questions you can ask.

Jobs:

1. Why is this position open?
2. What does a typical day look like in this position?
3. Is there room for advancement with this company?

Colleges/Scholarships:

1. Why should I choose your university?
2. Can you tell me more about the scholarship donor?
3. How many candidates are applying for this scholarship? How many will be selected?
